

This is a fun drawing game that can be played by two people, but you can easily play with your whole family as well!

What you will need:

- A friend or two
- Something to draw with, like crayons, pencils, or markers
- One sheet of 8.5" x 11" paper for each person
- Stop watch or Clock (optional) to set a time limit for each section of your drawing


Objective:

CREATE wild and wacky "pARTy Monsters" together by drawing different parts of a Monster without knowing what the other person drew.

At the end, reveal your creations! It is always fun and a big surprise!

STEP 1:

Fold your sheet of paper into THREE equal parts (like the diagram on the right)



STEP 2:

In the top section, DRAW a HEAD and NECK.


Be CREATIVE and try to draw something fun or interesting.

Note:

- Make sure your neck ends at the fold
- Mark on the other side of the fold where your neck ends. (This is so the next person can line up their drawing of the BODY).

Remember:

Don't peek at each other's drawings!




pARTy Monsters

STEP 3:

When you are finished drawing the HEAD (or when the timer sounds), fold the top section back so the HEAD is no longer visible, then slide the paper over to the other person.

If you are playing with more than TWO people, slide the sheet of paper to the person on your RIGHT.




STEP 4:

Once you have switched papers, find the marks left by the last person and DRAW the BODY.


Note:

- Don't draw the legs! That's for the final section of the drawing. Only draw the torso and arms.
- Just like in STEP 2, make sure your drawing goes all the way from the top to the bottom fold.
- Make sure you mark where the body ends so the next person can make their LEGS/FEET line up.



STEP 5:

When you are finished drawing the BODY (or when the timer sounds), fold your paper over again and slide it to the next person.




STEP 6:

Once you have switched papers with your friend, DRAW the LEGS/FEET.

Note:

It doesn't have to have legs, it could have tentacles, fins, rollerblades, whatever.



STEP 7:

When everyone is finished their drawings (or when the final timer sounds), UNFOLD your sheet of paper and SHARE your “pARTy Monsters” with everyone!

Remember: It’s okay to laugh at how silly they look. That’s the whole point!
